


Rabbi Mark Sameth

Shavuot is the spring festival that commemorates receiving the Torah at Mt. Sinai. Tikkun Leil Shavuot is an observance created by the Kabbalists in the 16th - 17th centuries. They would study Torah all night to prepare themselves to spiritually "receive the Torah" once again. While we will join together for a briefer time and not all night, we will study with Rabbi Mark Sameth to engage in the spirituality of this special day. This year's gathering will include Reform synagogues from New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania and Texas.

We will begin at 7:30 pm with an engaging presentation by Rabbi Sameth based on the themes in his book *The Name: A History of the Dual-Gendered Hebrew Name for God.* Rabbi Sameth will then lead us in studying the Torah portion for Shavuot morning (which includes the 10 Commandments), through the lens of his new book. We will end the night with a Festival Maariv at 9:00 pm led by Rabbi Jordan Millstein and Cantor Nitza Shamah of Temple Sinai of Bergen County, New Jersey.
